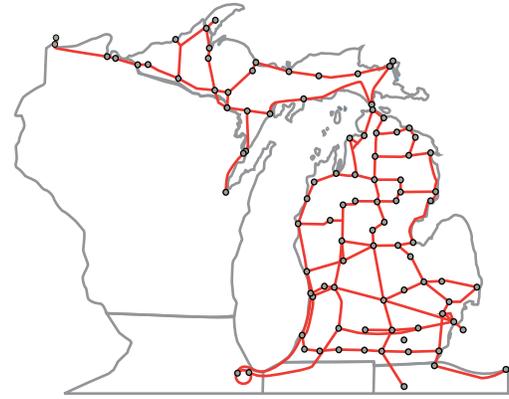


MERIT'S STATEWIDE FIBER-OPTIC NETWORK COVERS OVER 3,800 MILES

Merit's fiber-optic network provides high-speed Internet and network connectivity to hundreds of organizations across Michigan.

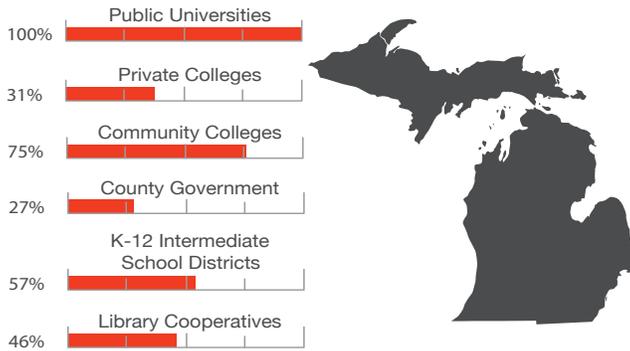
Merit's network shares exchange points with major carriers and other regional networks, and has peering agreements with over 20 networks.

Merit has nearly 50 years of experience in advanced networking. Our network has evolved to encompass a 100 Gbps facilities-based core network. Utilizing dark fiber, Merit has deployed CWDM and DWDM optical equipment to light and operate a state-of-the-art network across Michigan.
